

Yeager Airport & WV Air Guard 70th Anniversary Air Show Entry Restrictions

- ALL CARRY-IN ITEMS AND PERSONS ARE SUBJECT TO SEARCH.
- ALL UNATTENDED BAGS AND ITEMS WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE PREMISES.
- CAMERAS WILL BE USED TO MONITOR THE FACILITY.

THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTIONS APPLY:

- No Coolers (*medication/infant needs exception)
- No Loose Ice (*medication/infant needs exception)
- No outside food or drinks (*medication/infant needs exception)
- No Cans, Glass, or Plastic Bottles
- No Alcohol
- No Tents or Awnings
- No Cooking Equipment
- No liquids (*medication/infant needs exception)
- No weapons (regardless of permit) including: firearms, knives (including pocket knives and multi-tools), walking sticks (except for handicap use) and all other items that the security force deems dangerous. Any confiscated items will not be returned.
- No Smoking
- No Pets (other than service animals)
- No Bicycles, roller skates, roller blades or skateboards

FOR YOUR CONVENIENCE:

To minimize imposition, it is recommended that Air Show patrons bring only necessary items and limit the size and contents of carry-in items to those that are essential. FOR THE SAFETY OF EVERYONE, BY ENTERING YOU ARE SUBMITTING TO A SEARCH OF YOUR PERSON AND BELONGINGS.

Air Show concession stands feature a wide variety of food and beverage options for your enjoyment and convenience.

YOUR COOPERATION AND PATIENCE IS APPRECIATED.

The Yeager Airport Air Show will only permit the entry of small coolers carrying life-saving medicines or formula bottles for young infants.

Chairs, blankets and handheld umbrellas ARE permitted.

Answers to FAQs on Restrictions

- Food is NOT prohibited but it must be wrapped in clear wrapping or be in an unopened package and not in a cooler.

- Loose ice is prohibited because it is difficult to search. Ice packs ARE permitted.
- A “cooler” is anything that was designed to insulate.

Can I bring a fanny pack?

SMALL purses or fanny packs are permitted, subject to approval by gate security personnel and a thorough hand-search at the security checkpoint. Storage bags such as backpacks, briefcases, duffle bags, suitcases, and large camera bags ARE NOT permitted. THE DECISION OF THE GATE PERSONNEL IS DEEMED FINAL. Your safety is our #1 priority.

Can I bring a purse?

Small purses are permitted, subject to approval by gate security personnel and a thorough hand-search at the security checkpoint. Large purses (tote bag type), storage bags such as backpacks, briefcases, duffle bags, suitcases, and large camera bags ARE NOT permitted. THE DECISION OF THE GATE PERSONNEL IS DEEMED FINAL. Your safety is our #1 priority.

Can I bring a cooler, water, drinks and/or food?

Coolers, water, cans, glass and plastic bottles ARE NOT permitted. Please do not attempt to bring drinks other than items for infant needs. Outside food and beverages are NOT permitted, except for infant or medical needs. All items brought are subject to approval by gate security personnel and a thorough hand-search at security checkpoint. THE DECISION OF THE GATE PERSONNEL IS DEEMED FINAL. Your safety is our #1 priority.

Are umbrellas allowed at the Air Show?

Small “rain umbrellas” are fine to bring (small ones that fit in a purse or bag). Umbrellas with sharp or metal points are prohibited. THE DECISION OF THE GATE PERSONNEL, concerning umbrellas, IS DEEMED FINAL. Your safety is our #1 priority.

I have small children. Can I bring a stroller/diaper bag/clothes change/etc.?

Yes. Strollers will be hand-searched at the security checkpoint. Please bring only necessary items in a small diaper bag, subject to a thorough hand-search at the security checkpoint. Large diaper bags will not be permitted. *Small coolers are permitted for medication and infant needs but WILL BE searched. THE DECISION OF THE GATE PERSONNEL, concerning coolers and bags, IS DEEMED FINAL. Your safety is our #1 priority.

Can I bring folding chairs?

Yes. Small folding or camping chairs, like the type that come in carrying bags, are permitted. If you bring a chair that comes in a bag, please remove it from the bag prior to going through the security checkpoint so the chair and bag can be searched.

What will security be like the day of the show?

Be prepared for 100% security checks with metal detectors at the entrance. All hand-carried items WILL be searched. All confiscated items WILL NOT be returned.

Containers such as backpacks and coolers ARE NOT allowed to be brought into the show, you can leave them in your vehicle. Some exceptions will be made for items such as small diaper bags, small purses, and folding chairs. Visitors must submit them to security personnel for an inspection. Weapons of any kind are strictly prohibited. Weapons include, but are not limited to, firearms, blades (including pocket knives), blunt objects, edge weapons and pepper spray. Firearms will be immediately confiscated and will not be returned, pending a law enforcement investigation. Patrons with confiscated firearms will be asked to leave the installation. **THE DECISION OF THE GATE PERSONNEL, concerning weapons, IS DEEMED FINAL.** Your safety is our #1 priority.

Authorized Items

All authorized items will be inspected prior to entering the air show flight line. It is recommended that spectators minimize the number and size of authorized items to reduce the time required for inspection prior to access into the flight line area. **THE DECISION OF THE GATE PERSONNEL, concerning the number and size of authorized items, IS DEEMED FINAL.** Your safety is our #1 priority. The following items, in limited quantities, are permitted:

- Cell phones, tablets and FRS transceivers (may be asked to turn off / on)
- Handheld portable televisions, radios and scanners
- Small fanny packs and purses
- Cameras and camcorders (owners should not load film prior to entering the show area as they may be required to open all compartments at Security Checkpoints).
- Camera bags will be searched upon entry
- Folding chairs and lawn chairs (chairs removed from bags for search)
- Small umbrellas and sunshades
- Wheelchairs
- Baby bags and strollers, if attending with an infant or small child

Notes:

- Neither strollers nor wheelchairs will be available for rent at the Air Show
- Sun protection, including hat, long-sleeved shirts and long pants and sunscreen are recommended
- Water will be available for sale in the flight line area
- Wear comfortable footwear; the flight line is paved and you may walk long distances.
- All vendor vehicles will be subject to search.

And Finally,.....

Please keep in mind that **YOUR SAFETY IS OUR PRIMARY CONCERN.** Remember the following important safety tips:

- Uniformed security personnel are there to help. Follow all instructions from uniformed security personnel.
- Very few things on our flight line are soft to the touch; most things are made of metal and have lots of edges on them. Keep your eyes focused in the direction you're walking and be aware of low-hanging (and flying!) aircraft components.
- Medical personnel are on call to render assistance to anyone that requires it. Notify any uniformed security person or air show worker if you or anyone around you appears to need medical attention.
- A "lost children / medical / lost and found" tent will be located adjacent to the entrance gate
